WHEREAS, in accordance with section 124A(3) of the Education Reform Act 1988 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Privy Council by Order dated 5th March 1993 made an instrument of government for the Southampton Institute of Higher Education, being a higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect:

AND WHEREAS section 124A(3)(b) of the Act provides that the Privy Council may by Order modify an instrument of government of any such higher education corporation:

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the said instrument of government, the said Corporation have changed their name with the consent of the Privy Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, Their Lordships, in exercise of the powers conferred on Them by the said section 124A(3)(b), are pleased to, and do hereby, modify the said instrument of government in accordance with the provisions set out in the Schedule to this Order.

MODIFICATIONS TO THE INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT REFERRED TO IN THE
FOREGOING ORDER

In paragraph I (1) for "the Southampton Institute of Higher Education" in each place where it occurs substitute "the Southampton Institute".
