This section of the Handbook sets out the role and authority of the University as a Higher Education Corporation, that of its Board of Governors, of individual Governors in general and of various office holders. The sections covering these roles draws heavily on the latest guidance contained in the University Chairmen publication entitled *Guide for Members of Higher Education Governing Bodies in the UK*. The section concludes with a summary of arrangements for Governor indemnity and insurance.

**Section 6ii** summarises the matters for which the Board of Governors is responsible arising formally from its Instrument and Articles of Government.

Section 6iii summarises the role and responsibilities of individual Governors.

**Section 6iv** summarises the role and responsibilities of the Chairman of the Board of Governors; **Section 6v** the role and responsibilities of the Vice-Chancellor; and **Section 6vi** the role and responsibilities of the Clerk to the Governors.

**Section 6vii** sets out the arrangements that the University has in place for Governor indemnity and insurance and the disclosure and reporting requirements placed on Governors and the University respectively.
